



## California Standardbred Sires Stakes Breeders Incentive Program

### **\$1,500 one-time bonus offered for 2010 breeding to a Registered California Stallion that results in a USTA registered foal in 2011**

Owners of mares bred in 2010 to a CSSSC Registered California Standardbred Stallion will be eligible to a one time only payment of \$1,500 upon presentation of USTA registration for resulting offspring.

- **Late Stallion registrations** will be accepted until July 1, 2010 for \$500. California law prevents out of state semen transfers; mare & stallion must be located in California for mating although foals may be born out of state. CSSSC policy states that a potential sire shall not provide cover prior to registration.

### **Broodmares must be registered with CA Sires Stakes**

- \$25 by July 1, 2010 OR \$50 after July 1 and by September 1, 2010

### **November 1, 2011 deadline to submit USTA Registration for foal**

Incentive payments will be issued between July 1, 2011 and December 31, 2011 upon receipt of USTA registration for offspring of the registered Broodmare and Registered California Sire.
